


4 Culture of Work / Life Balance

Culture of Work / Life Balance In Action as a Proposal Professional

- Develop proposal SOPs that support work/life balance
- Schedule out of office time and socialize early (and confidently)
- Take time back
- Block calendar
 - Outside of working hours
 - Friday afternoons
 - Focus or training time
